


# Irish LGBTQI+ Housing Related Publications



#### Introduction

#### Overview of the paper:

As part of Pride Month, the Policy & Practice team at The Housing Agency carried out a literature search to bring together in one place a list of housing and accommodation related research and publications which provide insights into the experience of LGBTQI+ people in Ireland.

Information about the experiences of the LGBTQI+ community in Ireland is included in various publications, this includes the <u>ESRI's European survey data on attitudes to equality groups and human rights</u> (2019) as well as the <u>EU's LGBT survey data</u>. However, information relating specifically to the housing and accommodation experiences of LGBTQI+ individuals in Ireland is more limited. It is worth noting that there is a larger volume of research available about the housing experiences of LGBTQI+ people internationally, particularly from the UK, US and Canada.

#### The methodology used:

The research and publications found in this paper were accessed by using key word searches on Scopus and Google Scholar. Additional grey literature was accessed by directly searching publications produced by organisations such as the ESRI and NESC as well as LGBTQI+ charities and advocacy groups. The search was restricted to publications that provide insights into the housing or accommodation experiences of LGBTQI+ individuals in Ireland in the 2014 to 2024 time period

#### The structure of the paper:

This paper is structured as a bibliography, providing the title, reference and access link to the 11 publications that were found to meet the criteria of; providing insights into the LGBTQI+ experience of housing in Ireland for the 2014 to 2024 time period which were publicly available.
