

Co-housing is a new way of living in a community of like-minded people over 50 who wish to remain in their neighborhood and follow a more sustainable lifestyle. It meets the housing needs of the new middleagers by creating an environmentally friendly urban development that is a 'blue zone' for the over-50s.









What do we mean by Cohousing Communities for people 50+

Cohousing communities for people aged 50+ are intentional living arrangements where older adults come together to live in a shared, supportive environment.

These communities are designed to foster social interaction, mutual support, and a sense of belonging while allowing for independent living.

The goal is to create a balance between private living spaces and communal areas where residents can share resources, activities, and responsibilities.

THE SIX CHARACTERISTICS OF COHOUSING

1.COLLABORATIVE

DEVELOPED, DESIGNED, AND ORGANIZED TOGETHER.

2. SOCIAL

A COMMUNITY OF 'GOOD' NEIGHBOURS - DESIGNED TO PROMOTE COMMUNITY INTERACTION.

3. HIGH QUALITY

HIGH QUALITY AND 'A' RATED FUTURE PROOFED HOMES

4. INDEPENDENT

HOMES INDIVIDUALLY OWNED.

5. SELF-MANAGED

FULLY OWNER MANAGED - NO HIERARCHY IN DECISION MAKING

6. SHARED SPACES

FACILITIES THAT ENHANCE AND SUPPORT DAILY LIFE.




